### Getting To Know Your Groundwater

This workshop, run by 4T Consultants, is designed to give a good understanding of how groundwater works, and how individual landholders can monitor their own groundwater levels. The workshop will include information on local geology and conditions, and enable landholders to recognise groundwater trends on their property. Using Skype, the workshop will include presentations from a number of groundwater experts. Participants will have access to a central water level metre to measure their own bores or guidance to install leased or low-cost equipment for monitoring of water levels.
