III unit of competency in Water Quality Monitoring. The course covers 'Collection and Analysis' of water quality samples. The course enables participants to collect and analyse water samples correctly and accurately.

Site Managers can be confident that the samples collected will be in accordance with the Queensland Department of Environment and Heritage Protection Guidelines.

During training, participants will learn how to sample in accordance with the Queensland Monitoring and Sampling Manual 2009 V.2 (DEHP).

Training can be conducted at your own site. You will learn how to:

Prepare for a sampling event; Identify holding times; Use correct sample containers; Avoid sample contamination;
